

Board moves forward on garden proposal

The DCCC Board of Trustees and Sunflower Community Garden board members approved a location for a community garden on campus.

A garden committee, comprised of Sunflower Community Garden members and DCCC officials, met to look at different areas of campus for the garden. The proposed garden area is located northeast of the Technical Center along Highway 50 with an orchard area located east of the garden.

The Sunflower Community Garden brought a proposal to the board in September asking to use land on the south side of the campus near the water tower. One issue facing the originally



proposed location was an access lane and parking lot. The new location already has 47 yards of asphalt in place and room for expansion to take care of parking needs. "The selected area is going to be less expensive to develop as far as roadways go. So I

would think we would extend an asphalt drive," said Terry Malone, DCCC Trustee and Sunflower Community Garden member.

Board attorney Glenn Kerbs will now draft a lease agreement to be considered by the board in February.

Two programs receive Title IV approval

The Flight Instructor Program and the online nursing program have been approved by the United States Department of Education for Title IV student financial aid programs. The programs are the Pell Grant Program, the Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant, Federal Work Study Program and the Stafford Loan Program.

"We're going to be able to provide our students with federal Pell Grants if they're eligible and the other forms of aid. But more importantly they are going to be able to get access to the federally guaranteed low-cost loans and they won't have to borrow so much money in private loans at a higher interest rate," Dean of Student Services Anthony Lyons said.

In other business the board:

- Approved the 2009-2010 academic year calendar.
- Approved the 2009 Farm Lease Agreement with Stueckemann Farms Inc. for \$1,800.
- Approved a Cooperating Agency Agreement with Wesley Medical Center LLC for DCCC nursing students.
- Approved the purchase of 30 computer workstations at a cost of \$36,287 from KI Furniture. The workstations will be placed in the Academic Success Center. The funds are being provided by the Title V Grant.
- Approved the purchase of 46 computers from Dell Marketing for \$72,015.30. Thirty-two of the computers will be placed in two computer labs in the Academic success Center. Five of the computers will be placed in the ASC for staff use, and nine will be used to upgrade computers in the faculty training lab located in LRC 208. Funds are being provided by the Title V Grant.
- Approved a contract between DCCC and Rosetta Stone Ltd. For 25 Online Annual Fixed Licenses of Rosetta Stone Classroom Version 3 and teacher manuals at a cost of \$2,520. Funds are being provided by the Title V Grant.
- Accepted the resignation of Doris Frick, Director of the Child and Adult Care Food Program, effective May 1.
- Approved the employment contract of Hugo Perez, Cheerleading and Dance Coach/Admissions Representative.
- Approved an extended instructional contract for John Ewy, Professor and Coordinator of Communications.
- Approved the employment contract for Justin Weil, Associate Professor of Welding.
- Approved the employment contract for Ryan Ausmus, Director of the Adult Learning Center.
