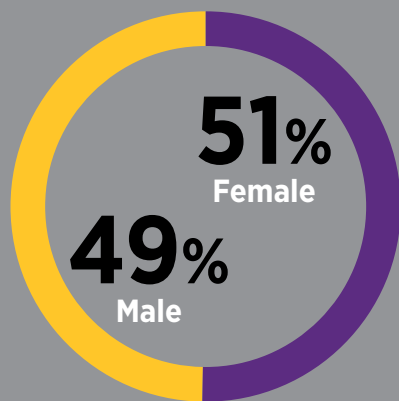


Why DC3?

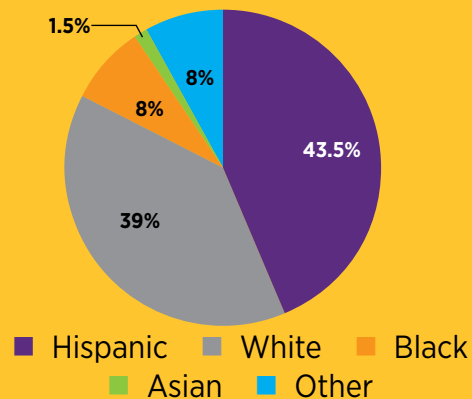

Campus Diversity

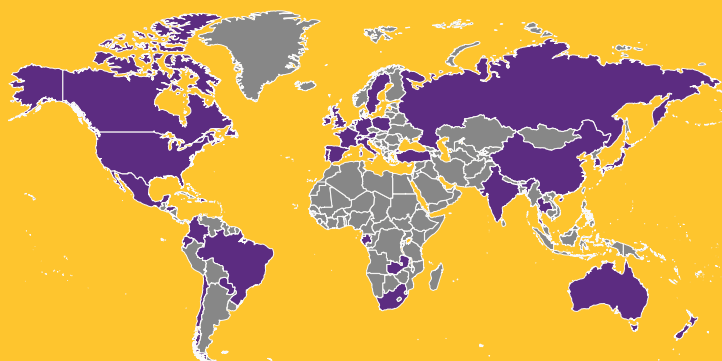
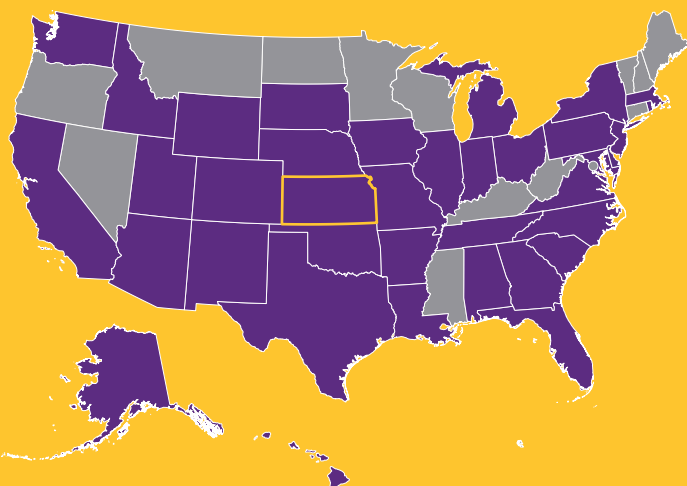

access to:

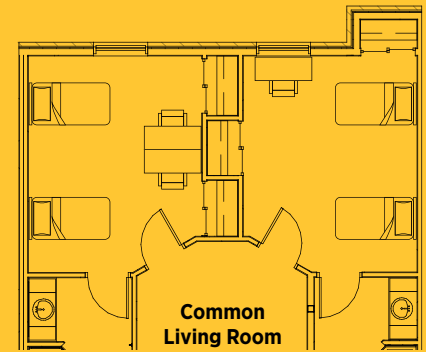
- FREE laundry facilities

- WiFi and cable TV hookups



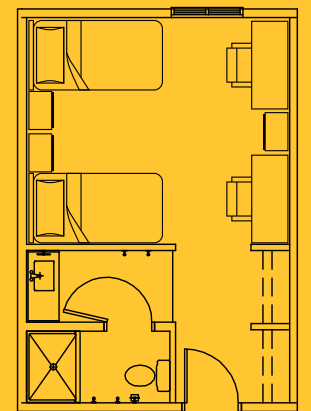
