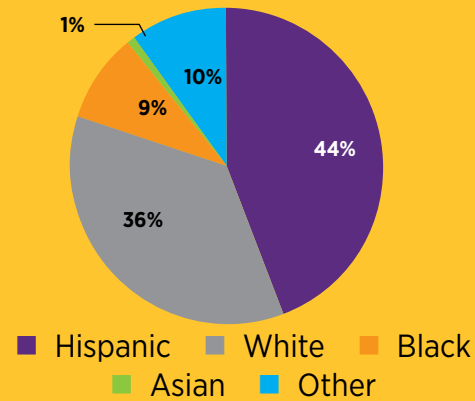

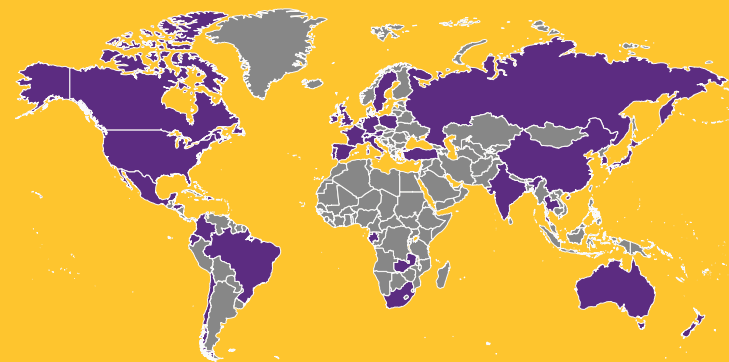
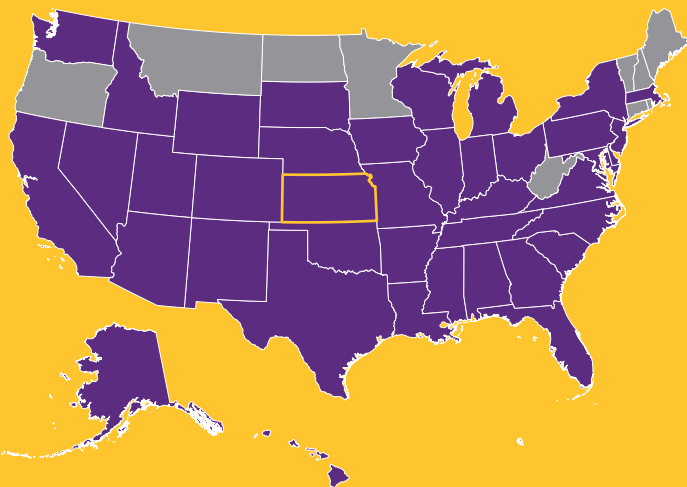


Why DC3?

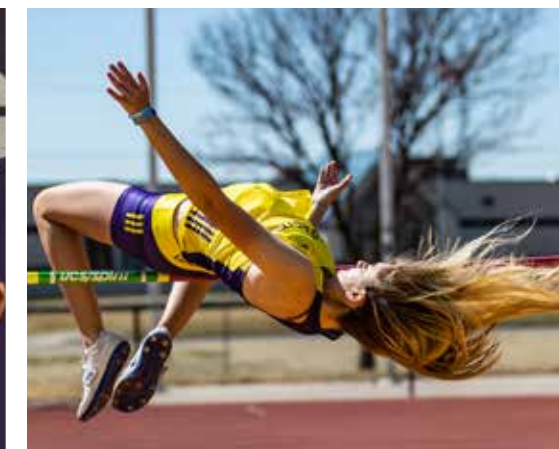

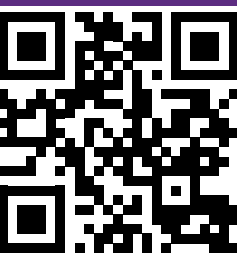

Each hall also provides

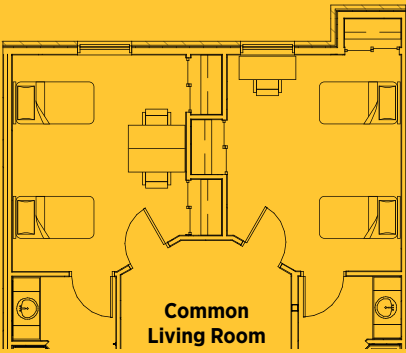
access to:

- WiFi and cable TV hookups

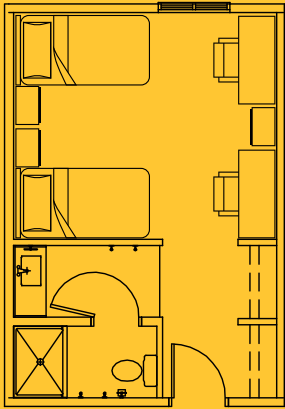

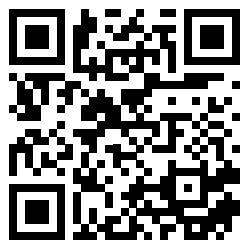
JACKSON HALL

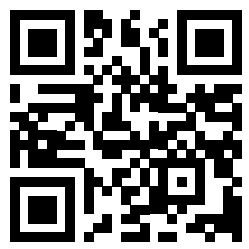
